Historians and geographers have traditionally traced these origins to the eighteenth-century Scotch-Irish and German settlers of the Pennsylvania backwoods. Jordan and Kaups reject this view, identifying seventeenth-century Delaware Valley Finns and their Indian neighbors as the major shapers of frontier culture. Their findings are especially timely, since today's problems of habitat destruction and massive environmental change have their roots in America's pioneer mentality.
